



CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

While Sunbrella® looks and feels like cotton canvas, it is engineered to resist degradation and fading through years of regular use, even in direct sunlight and nature's elements that destroy conventional fabrics in months.

Cleaning couldn't be easier! Sunbrella® is unaffected by most household cleaning products, and the color cannot be faded or washed out of the fabric.

General Cleaning: For light dirt and dust, Sunbrella may be cleaned with garden hose or warm tap water and mild soap.

Machine Washing: Sunbrella® may be machine washed using cold water and natural soap. Sunbrella® will air-dry extremely quickly. If you prefer tumble drying, use low heat.

Spot Cleaning: For specific stains, Sunbrella® may be cleaned with an appropriate household cleaning agent. Please refer to the chart below for some suggested common stains.

IMPORTANT: Be sure to rinse Sunbrella® thoroughly after using a strong cleaning agent, as any residual chemicals left on Sunbrella® may damage other fabrics or irritate skin. | BEER | liquid detergent, white vinegar | MILDEW | 1/2 cup of bleach and 1/4 cup natural soap per gallon of water |
| BERRY | liquid detergent / ammonia (3-6% water) | MILK | liquid detergent |
| BLOOD (DRIED) | detergent / ammonia (3-6% water) | NAIL POLISH | volatile solvent (<i>acetone</i>) |
| BUTTER | volatile solvent (<i>acetone</i>) | OIL | volatile solvent (<i>acetone</i>) |
| CHARCOAL, PENCIL MARKS | vacuum, then liquid detergent | ORANGE DRINK | liquid detergent, water |
| CATSUP OR MUSTARD | liquid detergent | PAINT (LATEX) WET | liquid detergent, water |
| CHEWING GUM | volatile solvent (<i>acetone</i>) | PAINT (LATEX) DRY | paint, oil or grease remover |
| CHOCOLATE | liquid detergent, ammonia water | PAINT (OIL / LACQUER) | paint, oil or grease remover |
| COFFEE | detergent, white vinegar, volatile solvent (<i>acetone</i>) | SHOE POLISH (LIQUID) | volatile solvent (<i>acetone</i>) |
| COLA | liquid detergent | SHOE POLISH (WAX) | apply heated iron over towel, volatile solvent (<i>acetone</i>) |
| CRAYON | paint, oil or grease remover | SUNTAN LOTION | Pine Power® or pine oil detergent |
| EGG (RAW) | liquid detergent | TEA | liquid detergent |
| GRAPE JUICE | liquid detergent | TOMATO JUICE | liquid detergent |
| GRAVY | liquid detergent | TREE SAP | turpentine, liquid detergent |
| GREASE (CAR) | volatile solvent (<i>acetone</i>) | URINE | liquid detergent, white vinegar |
| INK (PERMANENT, INDIA, BALLPOINT) | paint remover, volatile solvent (<i>acetone</i>), detergent | VOMIT | detergent, water, white vinegar |
| IRON RUST | oxalic or citrus acids, water | WATER COLOR | liquid detergent, water, white vinegar |
| LIPSTICK | paint, oil or grease remover | WAX (CANDLE) | apply heated iron over towel, volatile solvent (<i>acetone</i>) |
| MASCARA | paint remover, volatile solvent (<i>acetone</i>), detergent, water | WINE | liquid detergent / ammonia (3-6% water), white vinegar |
